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WHEREAS;

The SETTLOR/AUTHOR is desirous of creating and establishing a fund for the public religious and charitable objects and purposes in India hereinafter expressed.

WHEREAS;

The TRUSTEES have at the request of the SETTLOR/AUTHOR agreed to act as TRUSTEES of these presents upon the terms and provisions hereinafter contained.

Whereas;

A meeting of the present SETTLOR/AUTHOR and TRUSTEES was held on 28th day of September, 2012 and it has been unanimously decided to constitute a trust in the name and the style of "SRI RAMESHWAR CHARITABLE TRUST"



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(hereinafter referred to as "THE TRUST") for the all round development of the people of India in general and of Odisha in particular.

the office of the TRUST shall be situated for the time being at -The TRUST, without any discrimination to the caste or religion, shall devote itself for the Education, Health, Socio-Economic upliftment and overall development of the people of India in general and Odishain particular.

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSES as follows:

1. The TRUST shall be known and recognized in the name of style of **SRI RAMESHWAR CHARITABLE TRUST** and shall have its permanent office at **HARE KRUSHNA BALARAM COMPLEX, SAMARAIPUR, GELPUR, MADHAB NAGAR, BHADRAK, PS- BHADRAK RURAL, BHADRAK - 756181, Dist - BHADRAK, Odisha** which may and can be shifted to such other place or places as and when felt necessary and the TRUSTEES may deem fit and proper at their discretion.

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2. With the request of the members **TRUST**, Sri Debasis Dixit was offered to act as the **MANAGING TRUSTEE** of the **TRUST** who with all humility accepted the same and also assured the trustees to act and discharge the duties and responsibilities to the best of his abilities.
3. In order to effectuate the said objects of creating and establishing a Public Charitable Trust, the **SETTLOR/AUTHOR** has delivered to and made over to the **TRUSTEES** a sum of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand) only with intent to part with all his right, title, interest and claim therein and vest the same in the **TRUST** to have and to hold the same and the investment or investments for the time being representing the same and all other properties that may for the time being represent the trust estate together with all additions and accretions thereto and all accumulated income thereof and all other property or properties that may be acquired out of the same or otherwise may hereafter be subject to the **TRUST** (hereinafter referred to as the **TURST FUND**) for charitable objects and purposes and uses hereinafter expressed with the powers and on the terms and conditions herein contained of and concerning the same.



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4. OBJECTS: The objects of the Trust shall be:

- I. To establish promote, setup, run, maintain, assist, support in the field of education, health all sort of welfare, environmental protection, extending service at the time of natural calamity, information technology, tourism, eradication illiteracy etc.
- II. To establish promote, setup, run, maintain, assist, finance support and/or aid to or help in the setting up and/or maintaining and/or running school, college other institution or other establishments.
- III. To organize various programmes, events towards fund raising and helping the development of the down trodden & the under privileged.
- IV. To provide any type of support as it deems fit to the meritorious and poor students.



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- V. To give provide and render proper education in scientific method to the deserving students.
- VI. To render monetary and/or other help and assist for the relief of students, to give donation subscription or contribution to institutions establishments centers or persons doing relief for the upliftment of education, students and educational institution.
- VII. To open, establish, promote, set-up, run, maintain, assist finance, support and/or aid or help in the setting up and/or maintaining and/or running schools, colleges, lecture halls and other establishments or institutions for advancement of education and of knowledge in arts, science, literature, humanities and all other useful subjects in all their manifestations.
- VIII. To orient Institutions of higher learnings, research and development establishment in search of truth and innovations for economic material and moral prosperity of mankind.

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- IX. To setup promote maintain and expand technical, management and healthcare education system to cater towards economic, social, and comparative excellence with the best of world.
- X. To open, found, establish, promote, set-up, run maintain, assist finance, support and/or aid or help in the setting up and/or maintaining and/or running hostels, boarding house, libraries, reading-rooms, gymnasium and other training and vocational institutes.
- XI. To promote, advance and encourage and/or aid in helping, promoting, advancing and encouraging primary, secondary and higher education including technical and medical education also physical training, training of handicrafts, fine art and other useful arts, crafts among the public including the establishment and maintenance of Shilpa-Shikshalayas, Kala-Kendras and other welfare centers for them.
- XII. To establish promote, expand vocational institutions aimed at creating a large pool of skilled manpower to cater to the requirements of industrial, commercial and academic institutions and organizations.
- XIV. To grant, pay or give scholarship, stipends, prizes, rewards, allowance and other financial assistance or help in cash or kind to students with a view to help them in prosecuting their studies in schools, colleges, educational institutions, technical institutions, art schools, institutions, teaching commercial and other arts including teaching of cultural arts of other training, research or educational works in India or abroad.
- XV. To train and send preceptors, instructors, social workers and other competent persons to various places for the welfare of the people.
- XVI. To act as a catalyst for co-coordinating between the Government Agencies and various Voluntary Organisations with a viewpoint to channelize Govt. aids for social welfare.
- XVII. To promote social forestry and plantation by the tribal & villagers in the rural belt with a view to re-establish the ecological balance.

- XVIII. To give, provide, and/or render monetary and/or other help and assistance for the relief of persons and animals affected by natural and other calamities such as flood, fire, famine, cyclone, earthquake, storm, accident, pestilence, drought, epidemic, unbearable cost of living and the like, to give donations, subscription or contributions to institutions, establishments, centres or persons doing relief work on such occasions.
- XIX. To propagate the cause of villagers, down trodden and tribal through publication of magazines, leaf lets, pamphlets, periodicals, articles in newspapers and other audio video means.
- XX. To establish & manage schools, colleges, student homes and libraries for helping the poor students.
- XXI. To grant scholarships, stipends, financial help to deserving students to enable them to continue with their studies.
- XXII. To give, provide, distribute blankets, rugs, woolen clothing, quilts of cotton, woolen, silk or other varieties of cloths or other articles of necessity and facilities for the poor, vaccinate the infants or babies, and to provide sports materials to the athletes and also to the clubs and other people of the community.
- XXIII. To acquire furniture & fixture, books, equipment as may be necessary for the trust.
- XXIV. To utilize the income and/or assets of the trust for charitable purpose only.
- XXV. To accept any gift, to purchase or in exchange hire, take over property moveable or immovable for the purpose of the trust.
- XXVI. To hold Seminar and Crusades at different levels.
- XXVII. To establish, maintain or acquire library or socio-spiritual libraries for the benefit of the students, community and mass.
- XXVIII. To raise loans with or without interest as the executive committee may decide from time to time.

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- XXIX. To open, fund, establish, promote, set-up, improve, extend, grant donation, assist, run, maintain, finance and/or aid or help in the setting of and/or maintaining and/or running hospitals, boarding houses, libraries, reading rooms, gymnasium, x-ray plants, dispensaries, maternity house, recreation centre, school, colleges, industrial and technical schools, spiritual and vocational institutions.
- XXX. To promote school of evangelism and confirm the holy scriptures in urban and rural areas as well as in the remote pockets and hilly areas of different parts of India and specifically in Odisha.
- XXXI. To meet traveling, boarding and lodging expenses for students going abroad for higher commercial and technical education.
- XXXII. To accept donations, grants, gifts and other offering and to deal with the same for the purpose of the Trust within India and abroad.
- XXXIII. To open, found, establish, promote, set-up, maintain, assist, finance, support, and/or aid or help in the setting up and/or maintaining and/or running hospitals, charitable dispensaries, maternity homes, child welfare centers, convalescent homes, sanatoriums, and/or aid to the suffering humanities or for research centers and institutions for promotion of research and education for medical science including surgery.
- XXXIV. To make people enable to fight for their rights as well as to fight against exploitation, violence and social injustice.
- XXXV. To provide psychological and physical support to the aged persons through running of old age homes and orphanage centers for orphan children.
- XXXVI. Collection and compilation of various basic data for project formulation and preparation of project reports.
- XXXVII. Undertake studies, survey, research, and action research in areas directly and indirectly linked to development of disadvantaged communities.

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XXXVIII. Undertaking project evaluation and appraisal in special project areas covered under MGNREGA and various other individual oriented and community Schemes undertaken by the Government and other Agencies.

XXXIX To take up peripheral development activities for PAPs and PDPs around industries set up in various areas keeping their over all development of the area.

XXXIX. Undertaking training programmes for eradicating female illiteracy schemes, vocational training, cottage and small industries and other related activities.

XL. Organising programmes on Child/Women's welfare population control, labour welfare, eradication of child labour, adult education and other schemes of socio-economic development.

XLI. Organising "Integrated Village Development Programme" in Tribal and Non-Tribal district, development for

- Cattle development.
- Goat improvement.
- Poultry keeping.
- Children diseases immunity work.
- Care of pre-school goers and expectant mothers.
- Nursery education.
- Village sanitations, and
- Village Panchmandali
- Social forestry and environment
- Health and sanitation programme including running of Hospitals.

XLII. Organisation of special course for farmers and their families to educate them on developing technologies in Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, cottage, Industries, Horticulture, Pisciculture and personal sanitation measures.

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- XLIII. Organizing orientation training programmes – Refresher's Training Courses – in the fields for workers engaged in Agriculture, Cattle Development, Poultry Development, Fresh Farming, orchards raising, Organising Co-operative, Road Safety, Health and Sanitation etc.
- XLIV. Development of village forests and Tree & Herbal Plantation activities in the rural/urban areas for preservation of ecology.
- XLV. Popularising use of common chullas and community kitchen – USE ONLY ONE PIECE OF FIRE WOOD PER FAMILY PER DAY: - Female folks to be educated around the community kitchens.
- XLVI. Organising the village cattle hats by providing: -
- Shelter for animals.
 - Typing animals meant for sale.
 - Plantation of quick growing shade-bearing trees to act as wind breaks for protecting animals and providing shade.
 - Provision of wells and water troughs for animals.
 - Arranging accommodation and shelters for seller/buyers.
 - Arranging sale and supply of cattle fodders at the Hats.
 - Provision of canteens with tea, coffee, soft drinks, snacks etc. for the buyers and sellers.
 - Arrangement for quick transport, Trucks with loading and unloading points for transportation to markets.
- XLVII. Popularising establishment of "Soolabh Sauchalaya" in rural areas and utilization of these "Sauchalaya" for production of Biogas for street lighting purposes.
- XLVIII. Mobilise rural and urban population and operate health and sanitation programmes including fight against leprosy, T.B., AIDs, Hepatitis, STD and other diseases.
- XLIX. Educating and creating public awareness on environment, hazards and precautions for population in such areas and around industrial areas – Environment and Pollution Control.

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- L. Fostering Communal harmony and amity amongst various religious communities by fostering closer understanding through various means.
- LI. Creating public opinion and awareness for water shed management practices to conserve and make optimum used of water by adoption of appropriate technologies.
- LII. Observance of road safety by maintaining roads properly and encouraging proper voluntary bodies-prompt petty road repairs to pot holes, rain cuts by voluntary bodies – utilization of Govt. funds for maintenance of road signs, Road Zebra marking, Road hums etc. by public voluntary organizations.
- LIII. Saving of drinking water running away from leaky road side water columns by undertaking timely repairs.
- IV. Teaching rural population on suitable measures to reduce drudgery in work to improvise rural transport i.e., Bullock Cart with some intermediate technologies to make these means of transport more comfortable and more efficient to carry bigger loads with less strain on the draught animals.
- LV. Developing, improvising and polarizing low cost housing technology in rural and urban area.
- LVI. To arouse a sense of social hygiene in place of worship, cinema halls, theatre halls and other public places.
- LVII. To educate the people to become law abiding by providing basic knowledge of the concerned laws of the land and providing timely and correct information about the Government's policies through training, media, leaflets, etc.
- LVIII. To undertake various programmes for the welfare of the old, infirm and other handicapped people as also to take up different kinds of programmes to fight against the evils of drinks and abuse of drugs, untouchability, dowry system and such other social evils which are gradually becoming a major threat to society and for the purpose,

avail of the facilities and aids offered by the State and Central Government.

- LIX. To collaborate and cooperate with any other association having these or similar objects either in part or whole.
- LX. To collect raw materials from the cultivators for the smooth transaction of said materials to the supplier and/or any other.
- LXI. To purchase/take lease land(s) from private/Govt./grant lease for the purpose of the trust.
- LXII. To get affiliation/reorganization/franchise, to extend affiliation/reorganization/franchise, for the purpose of the trust.
5. Office- The office of the Trust shall be, for the present, is to be located at HARE KRUSHNA BALARAM COMPLEX, SAMARAIPUR , GELPUR , MADHAB NAGAR , BHADRAK, PS- BHADRAK RURAL, BHADRAK – 756181, Dist – BHADRAK, Odisha . The Board of Trustees may, in future, decide to change the permanent head office to any other place and/or decide to have any number of branch offices as and where needed.
6. **MANAGEMENT & POWERS-** The management of the Trust shall vest with the Board of Trustees changed, altered or reconstituted from time to time, as is deemed fit and proper. From among themselves, the Board of Trustees shall choose one Chairperson, one Managing Trustee and one Treasurer. On the request of the Trustees, Sri Debasis Dixit took up the responsibility of the Managing Trustee. Smt Mamata Manjari Dixit shall be the first Chairperson and Smt Jayashree Kar shall be the first Treasurer of the association.
7. The persons holding the office of Chairperson, and Treasurer shall continue till such time as the Board of Trustees by resolution determine and decide and in no case their term shall not be less than 3 years;
- Provided that such person or persons may be removed from their office before the expiry of such minimum period of 3 years on the ground of fraud and gross illegalities by resolution of the Board in a meeting with at least fifteen days prior notice and passed by a majority of the total number of trustees with 3/4th members present and voting

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Provided further that this above proviso shall not be made applicable to Sri Debasis Dixit, the Managing Trustee who has the option to continue till such time as he desires.

8. A person shall cease to be a trustee only in the following cases, namely:
- (i) If he/she dies or resigns,
 - (ii) If he is declared as insolvent, insane or of unsound mind;
 - (iii) If he is convicted of any offence for moral turpitude;
 - (iv) If he is removed on grounds of fraud, illegalities and allegations of acting against the interest of the Trust, such removal being made in a resolution of the Board with the support of at least half of the total number of the members of the Board and two-thirds of the members present and voting.

9. The total number of trustees shall be 4 at the beginning and can be increased to 9 at the most.

Provided that in order to facilitate the smooth functioning of the trust and with the purpose achieving its objectives as mentioned above, the Board of trustees may by a simple majority co-opt such person/persons as associate trustees who have the right to take part in the discussions of the Board without any right to vote.

10. The Board of Trustees shall be reconstituted every three years. A Trustee may retire any time without assigning reason and without being responsible for any cost occasioned by such retirement. The surviving or continuing trustees may notwithstanding any vacancy in their board act as trustees PROVIDED HOWEVER that if the number of trustees shall fall below four, the minimum fixed by these presents, the trustees shall not, except for the purpose of filling any vacancy, acts so long as the number is below the said minimum.
11. The power to appoint new or additional trustees, but so as not to exceed the maximum number and to fill vacancies in the office of the trustees, shall vest in the continuing trustees.
12. On a new or additional trustee being appointed and on his signifying his acceptance in writing to the effect of his accepting the appointment, the Trust Property shall automatically vest in his along with the other trustees for time being and he will be entitled to carry out all the duties and functions of a trustee without any other deed or writing.
13. The Board Trustees shall have power to appoint its officers and staffs for the smooth running of the programmes undertaken by the Trust; to decide and formulate rules and regulations for them and in case of such exigencies shall have the power to suspend, remove, dismiss, retrench

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and take such other disciplinary actions as is deemed fit and proper. In addition, the Board of Trustees has power to appoint managers, attorneys, legal and other advisors, solicitors, surveyors, engineers, architects, auditors et el and shall have equal power to put an end to such appointment.

14. The Board of Trustees have the power to add, amend, alter or strike off any portion of these rules by way of amendment passed by way of 2/3rd majority of the members present and voting and in no case, the same shall be less than the half of the number the total membership of the Board.

15. If any one or more of the objects specified in clause (3) of these presents are held not to be objects of a public charitable nature, the trustees shall not carry out such object or objects as if the same are not incorporated in these present but the validity of the trust created by these presents as a trust for public charitable purposes shall not be effected in any manner.

16. In furtherance of the above objective the TRUST may:

- a. Purchase, acquire, lease, rent, develop the lands and building and build, rebuild, renovate, remodel, preserve and maintain them
- b. Sale land or building already acquired and purchase such other suitable sites in their place if and when so deemed expedient
- c. Purchase, take on lease or in exchange or otherwise acquire any movable or immovable properties & construct, maintain buildings and to do all acts & deeds which may be expedient or necessary for the the said purpose.
- d. Co-operate, collaborate, take over, join hands, manage other institutions or trusts with objective similar to those of the trust.
- e. Enter into contract, agreement, partnership and any company, private or public limited, for objectives with same and/or similar to the present trust.
- f. Do such other act/acts as is deemed fir and proper for the benefit of the trust and is intended to achieve the objects of the trust.

17. The Board of Trustees are fully empowered to raise funds by way of donations, grants, contributions, aids, subscriptions, and also from burrowings from individuals, societies, banks and such financial institutions with or without interest with proper acknowledgement and assurances.

18. The Board of trustee shall not at any time sell, mortgage or otherwise encumber any of the immovable properties of the Trust unless such sale, alienation or encumbrance is in the interest of the trust and its objectives and agreed upon by 2/3rd majority of the trustees.
19. The Trust is to sue and be sued by the Managing Trustee only. The Managing Trustee shall have full power to compromise or compound all actions, suits, and other proceedings and settle differences and disputes touching the Trust Estate under the Trust Properties and to refer any such differences or disputes to arbitration and the like, to adjust and settle all accounts relating to the Trust Estate and/or the Trust Properties and to do all other acts and things fully and effectually without being liable or answerable for any bonafide loss occasioned thereby.
20. The Trustees may join, cooperate and amalgamate the trustees created by these presents or any portion thereof with any trust or institution having allied and or similar objects upon such terms as they may in their absolute discretions think fit.
21. The Trustees may from time to time frame schemes and Rules and Regulations to carry out the objects of the trust and for managing the affairs of the trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects and purposes of the trust and to vary the same from time to time and as the trustees may in their discretion deem fit and proper.
22. The Trustees shall be entitled at their discretion from time to time to start, discontinue, abolish and restart any charity or charitable institution, to impose any condition or conditions to any subscription or donation made by them and to earmark any portion of the property or income for any remuneration.
23. The Trustees may reimburse themselves and pay and discharge out of the trust fund all expenses incurred by them in or about the execution of the trust or any of their duties under these presents including traveling expenses, but till not be entitled to any remuneration.
24. All the Trustees unless they voluntarily resign or otherwise decide, shall continue to be the trustees during the terms of their natural lives.
25. **FINANCE-** The financial year of the trust shall be counted from 1st April to 31st March and the calendar year will be treated from 1st January to 31st December every year.
26. **TRUST FUND-** The initial contribution of Rs.1,000 by the settler is to constitute trust fund. All subsequent contributions by the settler and trustees would be added to the said and would be a part of the Trust



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Fund. It shall be endeavor of all the trustees to try and work for increase in the trust fund through contributions/donations from other sources like individuals, separate bodies, groups, companies, corporate houses and the like; and also for grants from the governments. All such amount so acquired would be part of the Trust Fund.

27. The trust will open & operate a joint account in any Bank or financial institutions. The Managing trustee shall operate the said account **along with the Chairman**. It can also open Bank Account(s) in the name of any project staffs in any scheduled bank alone or jointly for smooth implementation of its specified programmes.
28. The Managing trustees shall cause true and accurate accounts to be kept of all moneys received and spent and of all matters in respect thereof in course of management of trust properties or in relation to the carrying out of the objects and purpose of the trust as well as of all the assets, credits and effects of the trust estate.
29. The trustees shall from time to time after meeting the expenses of and incidental to the management of the Trust Properties and of the Trust decide the particular object or objects for which the income or corpus of the Trust Fund or Properties for the time being available shall be applied.
30. The Board of Trustees may invest the Trust Estate either in the purchase of immovable properties or of mortgage immovable properties, or in such manner as allowed by law as may be in force from time to time and to convert, alter, vary, dispose of or transfer such investments from time to time as is deemed fit and proper.
31. The Board of Trustees shall be at liberty to sell such portion or portions of the movable or immovable properties forming part of the Trust Estate either by public auction or by private contract at such price or prices and in such terms and conditions relating to title or otherwise in all respects as they may in their absolute discretion think fit and to rescind or vary any contract for the sale thereof and to resell the same without being answerable for any loss occasioned thereby and to execute all conveyances and effectual receipts and discharges for all moneys received. In all such cases, there must be a resolution ratifying such contract and/or actions.
32. The trustees may accept any donation or contribution in cash or in kind from any person, firm, company, corporation, associations, institution or

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trust (including the settler or the trustees or any of them) for the furtherance of the objects of the trust or for any one or more of them upon such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit and which are not inconsistent with the objects of the trust. The trustees may also take over the management of any other charitable or public institutions on such terms as they think fit and may manage such institutions.

33. **MEETINGS-** The board of Trustees shall meet at least once in every quarter of the Gregorian calendar and a minimum 4 shall be the quorum of the meeting. Such meeting can be fixed either on a specific day or else be decided by the Chairperson and the Managing Trustee, in consultation with each other. In case of any disagreement on the date of such meeting, the words of the Chairperson shall be final. In the event of a meeting being adjourned for want of quorum, the adjourned meeting is to be held at least one day after the first meeting where question of quorum cannot be raised.
34. All meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be presided over by the Chairperson and in his absence, the members present shall chose one among them to preside over the meeting till the arrival of the Chairperson. The decision of the chair, in case of matters of dispute, shall be final.
35. All proceedings and questions and matters arising at the meeting of the trustees shall be decided by a majority of votes and incase of equality of votes the chairman shall have a second or casting vote PROVIDED HOWEVER that notwithstanding anything herein stated no questions dealing with the disposal of the corpus of any of the trust properties and/or investments out of the trust corpus shall be decided except with the consent of the Chairman of the Trust.

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36. Notice of the meeting of the trustees and all communications may be sent to the trustees at their addresses registered for the time being in the records of the trust by such methods as would be decided by the trustees.
37. A resolution in writing circulated amongst all the trustees and signed by a majority of the trustees shall be as valid and effectual as if it had been passed at a meeting of the trustees duly called and convened.
38. The Managing Trustee is to maintain all records and registers, write down or cause to be written down the resolutions of the Board of trustees in the minute book, implement the decisions of the Board of trustees. He will manage the day to day activities of the trust and perform any other assignments as decided by the Board of Trustee from time to time. It is the duty of the Managing Trustee to convene the meeting of the Board of Trustees in consultation with the Chairperson.
39. The Treasurer shall be responsible for keeping the accounts, maintain the register of accounts relating to income and expenditure and place the same in each meeting of the Board for its approval. He is to operate the accounts of the Trust jointly with the Managing Trustee.
40. The minutes of the proceedings of every meeting of the trustees shall be entered in a book to be kept for that purposes and signed by the Chairman of such meeting or of the following meeting when they are read over and shall when so entered and signed be conclusive evidence of the business and other matters transacted at such meeting.
41. **DISSOLUTION-** The Board of Trustees in its wisdom with a majority of $\frac{3}{4}$ th of the members present and voting and not less than half of the total number of the trustees, may decide to put an end to the Trust in which case, all the assets of the Trust shall be resolved to vest in any other such Trust, in absence of which the same shall vest absolutely with the government.

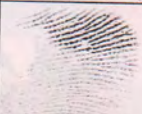
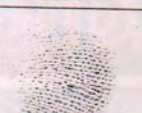
